



Dear JAS Assigner Applicant,

The NAWGJ JAS committee is accepting applications for collegiate assigners (2-3). The term may be a minimum of three years. The applications are due **by July 1, 2008 (in hand, not postmarked)**. We are hoping to have the decision made by August 1, 2008. Applicants will be chosen from different areas of the USA.

The position involves a major time commitment between September 15 and November 15 each season. In addition, you must be available on a weekly basis through the NCAA Women's gymnastic season to handle the last minute replacement of officials when emergencies arise (often on a Thursday or a Friday between January and March). It is a paid position based on the number of assignments you are given to assign by the National Assigner. Most assigners receive a minimum of \$1000.00. You must be flexible, open-minded, unbiased, fair and be able to work closely with other assigners and the National Assigner.
