NAWGJ in co-sponsorship with the NACGC/W will present a National Symposium, focusing on the NCAA Rule Modifications, including specific technique sessions which will address higher difficulty skills frequently performed skills at the collegiate level.

Target Population: Certified Level 10 through Brevet NAWGJ members. Level 9 judges will be placed on a waiting list. Priority given to areas of the country with a lack of qualified officials.

- **Vaulting** – Special requirements and rules applicable to the collegiate program and specific technique of selected vaults common at the collegiate level
- **Uneven Bars** - Special requirements on uneven bars and applicable composition, execution and choice of elements rules. Technique expectations for selected skills
- **Balance Beam** - Special requirements and choice of elements on beam and applicable composition and execution rules. Technique expectations for selected skills both acro and dance. Rewarding artistry and rhythm
- **Floor Exercise**- - Special requirements and choice of elements on floor exercise and applicable composition and execution rules. Technique expectations for selected skills both acro and dance. Rewarding artistry and rhythm
